- Remember, children are involved in cricket for their enjoyment, not yours;
- Encourage your child to play by the rules;
- Focus on the child's efforts and performance, rather than winning or losing;
- Remember that children learn best by example. Appreciate good performances and skillful play by all participants;
- Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate;
- Respect officials' decision and teach children to do likewise;
- Do not force an unwilling child to participate in cricket;
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game;
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities;
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion;
- Support the implementation of the document – 'Well Played: Australian Cricket's Playing Policies and Guidelines'
