



WSJCA U/14 RULES - TWO-DAY MATCHES

BATTING | BALLS IN THE MATCH (240) TO BE DIVIDED BY THE NUMBER OF BATTERS. BATTERS RETIRE AFTER FACING THEIR ALLOTTED NUMBER OF LEGITIMATE RULES.

UPON ALL BATTERS RETIRING OR BEING DISMISSED, THE REMAINING BALLS WILL BE DIVIDED AMONG THE RETIRED BATTERS. IF A RETIRED BATTER IS DISMISSED, THEIR REMAINING BALLS WILL BE SHARED WITH THE OTHER RETIRED BATTERS.

RETIRED BATTERS MAY RETURN TO THE CREASE PROVIDED THAT ALL PLAYERS HAVE FACED THEIR MINIMUM NUMBER OF BALLS AND TEN WICKETS HAVE NOT FALLEN.

THE INNINGS IS CLOSED AFTER 10 WICKETS HAVE FALLEN, OR 40 OVERS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED.

IF A TEAM HAS 10 PLAYERS, THEIR INNINGS WILL BE CLOSED SHOULD THEY LOSE 9 WICKETS ETC.

ALL MODES OF DISMISSAL COUNT, **INCLUDING LBW.**

BOWLING & FIELDING | 6 LEGAL DELIVERIES PER OVER ARE TO BE BOWLED, CAPPED AT A MAXIMUM OF 8 DELIVERIES PER OVER, EXCEPT THE LAST OVER WHERE 6 LEGAL DELIVERIES MUST BE BOWLED

WIDES & NO BALLS WILL INCUR A 1 RUN PENALTY.

NO FIELDERS WITHIN 10 METRES OF THE BATTER (EXCEPT WICKETKEEPER, SLIPS AND GULLY) FOR SAFETY.

BOWLERS ARE TO RECEIVE A WARNING FROM THE OFFICIATING UMPIRE PRIOR TO BEING CALLED FOR A FRONT FOOT NO BALL

11 FIELDERS MAXIMUM MAY BE ON THE FIELD AT ANY GIVEN TIME.

IF MORE THAN 11 PLAYERS ARE PRESENT AT A MATCH, ROTATION OF PLAYERS ON TO THE FIELD DURING THE INNINGS IS RECOMMENDED.

TEAMS HAVE THE OPTION TO CHANGE THEIR WICKETKEEPER AT DRINKS BREAKS.

PLAYERS THAT WICKETKEEP FOR THE ENTIRE INNINGS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BOWL

EACH PLAYER MUST BOWL A MINIMUM OF 3 X OVERS IN AN INNINGS

NO PLAYER MAY BOWL A 4TH OVER UNLESS ALL OTHERS HAVE BOWLED THEIR 3RD OVER.

BOWLERS MAY BOWL A MAXIMUM OF 6 OVERS.



WSJCA U/14 RULES - TWO-DAY MATCHES

OVERS | THE TEAM BATTING FIRST SHALL BE RESTRICTED TO A MAXIMUM OF FOURTY (40) OVERS OR 12:00PM (WHICHEVER COMES FIRST) AT WHICH TIME IT'S INNINGS MUST BE COMPULSORILY CLOSED.

THE SIDE BATTING SECOND SHALL RECEIVE, IN ITS FIRST INNINGS, AT LEAST THE SAME NUMBER OF OVERS AS THE SIDE BATTING FIRST (IF THAT INNINGS WAS COMPULSORILY CLOSED) UP TO A MAXIMUM OF FOURTY (40) OVERS.

OVERS MUST BE BOWLED ALTERNATIVELY FROM END TO END. COACHES MAY AGREE TO BOWL FIVE (5) OVER BLOCKS FROM THE SAME END TO SPEED THE OVER RATE UP, IF THIS IS DEEMED NECESSARY.

TEAM BATTING FIRST DISMISSED EARLY | IF THE TEAM BATTING FIRST IS DISMISSED IN LESS THAN IT'S ALLOTTED OVERS, THERE IS A TEN (10) MINUTE CHANGEOVER AND THE TEAM BATTING SECOND WILL BAT UNTIL THE SCHEDULED CLOSING TIME OF PLAY, REGARDLESS OF THE NUMBER OF OVERS BOWLED IN THE DAY.

DURING THE SECOND WEEK, THE TEAM BATTING SECOND IS ENTITLED TO IT'S FULL ALLOTTMENT OF FOURTY (40) OVERS AS WELL AS THE OVERS IT RECEIVED DURING THE FIRST WEEK.

THE BOWLING RESTRICTIONS DO NOT RESET FOR THE SECOND WEEK BUT CONTINUE TO APPLY THROUGHOUT THE WHOLE INNINGS. THE OVER RESTRICTIONS APPLY TO AN INNINGS, NOT A WEEK.

IF THE TEAM BOWLING DOES NOT HAVE SUFFICIENT PLAYERS TO EVENLY COMPLY WITH THE BOWLING RESTRICTIONS (MAXIMUM OF 6 OVERS, THEN THE OVERS LEFT SHOULD BE SPREAD AS EVENLY AS POSSIBLE AMONGST PLAYERS).

E.G. TEAM HAS ONLY 9 PLAYERS AND HAS TO BOWL A TOTAL OF 58 OVERS, 18 OVERS FROM THE FIRST DAY AND 40 OVERS FROM THE SECOND DAY.

THE 58 OVERS WOULD BE SPLIT: 5 X 6 OVERS AND 4 X 7 OVERS.

IF THE TEAM BATTING FIRST IS DISMISSED WITHIN 30 MINUTES OF THE SCHEUDLED CLOSE OF PLAY, THE TEAM BATTING SECOND IS NOT OBLIGED TO BAT ON THE FIRST DAY.

FOLLOW-ON AND DECLARATIONS | FOR A TEAM TO BE FORCED TO FOLLOW-ON, THAT TEAM MUST HAVE SCORED 50% OR LESS THAN THE OTHER TEAMS FIRST INNINGS TOTAL (E.G. AFTER THE TEAM BATTING FIRST SCORES 100 RUNS, THE TEAM BATTING SECOND SCORES 50 RUNS OR LESS, THEY CAN BE ASKED TO FOLLOW-ON AT THE DISCRETION OF THE TEAM THAT BATTED FIRST).

A TEAM MAY NOT DECLARE UNTIL ALL BATTERS HAVE FACED THEIR MINIMUM NUMBER OF BALLS OUTLINED IN THE TABLE BELOW
